

Health Care Services

School health services and school nurse services means health services that are designed to enable a child with a disability to receive FAPE as described in the child's IEP. School Health Services are services that may be provided by a qualified school nurse and is supported by a documented Health Care Plan. To document as a Related Service a Health Care Plan should be in place.

How to document Related Health Care Services

- Programs and Services Page in the IEP
- Under Related Services – Select Health Care Services
- Type of Service – Direct
- Frequency as stated on the Prescription
- Goal - Not required for Nursing Services
- Health care plan is attached to the student record as a file based document.

* Student's requiring emergency action plans for (Diasat, Versed, inhalers, EpiPen) should have nursing services documented in Supplementary Aids & Services page with the area of need listed within the PLAAFP.
